Terms of Approval

Design Organisation Approval Certificate EASA.21J.077

1. Scope of approval

This Design Organisation Approval has been granted for:

- designing in accordance with the applicable type-certification basis and environmental protection requirements:
 - 1) changes to aircraft related to avionics, cabin interior and aircraft electrical systems, connected with the necessary electronic and mechanical installations
 - 2) repairs to aircraft related to the above items 1) and structures
- showing and verifying the compliance with the applicable type-certification basis and environmental protection requirements, and
- demonstrating to the Agency this compliance.

2. Categories of products

Large and small aeroplanes

4. Privileges

(a) The holder of this design organisation approval shall be entitled to perform design activities under Part 21 and within its scope of approval.

(b) Subject to 21A.257 (b), compliance documents submitted by the holder of this design organisation approval for the purpose of obtaining

- a supplemental type-certificate; or
- a major repair design approval

shall be accepted by the Agency without further verification.

(c) The holder of this design organisation approval shall be entitled, within its terms of approval and under the relevant procedures of the design assurance system:

- (1) to classify changes to type design and repairs as "major" or "minor".
- (2) to approve minor changes to type design and minor repairs.
- (3) to issue information or instructions containing the following statement: "The technical content of this document is approved under the authority of DOA nr. EASA.21J.077."
- (4) to approve documentary changes to the aircraft flight manual, and issue such changes containing the following statement: " Revision nr. XX to AFM ref. YYY is approved under the authority of DOA nr. EASA.21J.077."

5. Limitations

(See in 1, above)

1. The designing of repairs for large aeroplanes is limited to minor structural repairs.

2. The designing of cabin changes is limited to the following changes:

- Changes of galley inserts
- Changes to installed monuments
- Changes to electrical/electronic communications and entertainment systems in the cabin
- Addition of small stowages to cabin, cockpit and cargo compartment

It does not include changes to the cabin layout and/or seats.
